Pre-Collection Criteria for Helicobacter Pylori Breath Test

The following pre-collection criteria are intended to help you prepare for the test your clinician has requested and reduce the risk of false negative results.

First, read the pre-collection criteria carefully, make sure your appointment is booked, and then follow each pre-collection criterion to ensure accurate results.

Prior to your Test:

- 1. Ensure that you are not allergic to citric acid.
- 2. You must pass the CoVid-19 Screening.
- 3. You must have **fasted for at least 4 hours**.

 Note: Drink water (no added flavor) as needed. Coffee or tea is acceptable **IF** no dairy/soy or sugar/sweeteners have been added (<u>see instruction #4</u>).
- 4. You must not drink any fluids **one hour** before the test.
- 5. You must be smoke-free for at least for 4 hours.
- 6. You must have waited at least 24 hours before repeating the Urea Breath Test.
- 7. You must have waited 6 weeks after last *H. pylori* treatment.

Antibiotics and acid lowering medication may interfere with this test and should not be taken for the periods indicated.

- 1. You must be **antibiotic-free for last 4 weeks.** (i.e., Tetracycline, Amoxil (Amoxicillin), Biaxin (Clarithromycin), Falgyl (Metronidazole))
- 2. You must be **bismuth preparation-free for last 2 weeks.** (i.e., Pepto-Bismol, Kaopectate)
- 3. You must be **proton pump inhibitor-free for last 7 days.** (i.e., Losec (Omeprazole), Prevacid (Lansoprazole), Pantaloc (Pantoprazole), Nexium (esomeprazole), Pariet (rabeprazole))
- 4. You must be **histamine H2 Receptor Antagonist-free for 1 day.** (i.e., Tagamet (cimetidine), Pepcid (famotidine), Zantac (ranitidine))
- 5. You must be antacid-free for 1 day. (i.e., Maalox, Diovol)

If you are taking **ANY** of these medications, it is recommended that you discuss this with your doctor **BEFORE** having the test done.

NOTE: Your test will be rescheduled if you do not meet all of the above criteria.



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
