

## Patient Instructions

### Lactose Tolerance Hydrogen Breath Test

Your doctor has requested that you have a Lactose Tolerance Hydrogen Breath Test performed. In order to produce a meaningful laboratory test result, you must follow these instructions.

The Lactose Tolerance test is not able to be performed on patients who are taking insulin. If your doctor has any questions or concerns, please have them call the Biochemist on call at LifeLabs.

#### Before you come to the lab:


- Do not eat, chew or drink anything (except small sips of water) for 8-12 hours before your appointment.
- No smoking for at least 2 hours prior to or during the test.
- No sleep or vigorous exercise is allowed for at least 30 minutes prior to or during the test.
- Antibiotics may interfere with this test and should be avoided for two (2) weeks prior to this test
- **This test is not covered by MSP. You are responsible for payment.**

#### When you arrive in the lab:

The test will take approximately 2 hours to complete. You will be expected to remain in the laboratory for the duration of the test. You will be asked to:

1. Provide the 1<sup>st</sup> breath sample (baseline)
2. Drink a sweet solution composed of 25 grams of lactose (milk sugar) with natural orange flavouring.
3. Wait 60 minutes (do not smoke, eat, drink or chew anything during this time) and provide the 2<sup>nd</sup> breath sample
4. Wait another 60 minutes (do not smoke, eat, drink or chew anything during this time) and provide the 3<sup>rd</sup> breath sample

If you feel any symptoms such as abdominal cramps, diarrhea, bloating, etc., please notify the staff.
