

Patient Instructions

Fecal Fat

24, 48 or 72 hour stool collection

Appointment Information

Your doctor has requested that you have a fecal fat test performed. In order to produce a meaningful laboratory test result, you must follow these instructions.

Collection Instructions

- 1. Collect the specimen directly into the container(s) provided. Do not mix urine or water with the specimen.
- 2. Print the time and date the collection started on the label that is attached to the container.
- 3. Collect all bowel movements passed for the next ___ hours into the container(s). For a 24 hour collection that was started at 8:00 am, the collection would finish the next day at 8:00 am.
- 4. Print the time and date the collection finished on the label that is attached to the container.

Labelling Instructions

- 1. Label each container with your name and date of birth
- 2. Ensure the date and time the collection was started and the date and time it was completed is on the label on the container.

Storage Instructions

- 1. Store the container upright with the lid sealed tightly.
- 2. For sanitary reasons, keep the container enclosed in the plastic bag provided.
- 3. It is important that the container be kept cool during collection and prior to returning to the lab.
- 4. If it is not possible to store the specimens in the refrigerator, the following storage alternatives are acceptable:
 - a. During cooler months, the container can be stored outside on a deck or in an unheated storage area where the temperature is less than 8° C.
 - Place the container in an insulated cooler with freezer packs to maintain a cool temperature. The freezer packs will require replacement over the collection period.

Packaging and Transport Instructions

- 1. The specimen must be brought to the lab as soon as possible after collection; preferably on the same day of collection.
- 2. Place the collection container into a plastic bag for transport and then into the white plastic bag provided.

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
