WHAT TO EXPECT DURING YOUR VISIT AT LIFELABS

- Many healthcare facilities such as LifeLabs continue to require additional measures such as face masks, hand sanitizing, and COVID-19 screening questions.
- Depending on capacity limits of the facility, you may be asked to stand in a line outside the Patient Service Centre door.
- You will be greeted by one of our staff members and asked to present your your requisition form and immigration documentation. Or, we may need to look it up if sent prior by you or your physician.
- Once we have your paperwork, we will process you in our system.
- Once we are ready for you, we will direct you to the appropriate area where a Lab Assistant will be there to perform the sample collection.

- Any health services related paperwork indicating coverage based on visitor, immigration or refugee status:
 - Interim Federal Health Program (IFHP) Certificate of Eligibility
 - E-medical Referral Letter
 - Notice to Return for Interview Letter

Make sure to bring a paper copy of the above documentation as it applies to you during your visit to LifeLabs.

Some tests are covered by the provincial B.C Health Plan if you have a valid health card, or if you qualify for the IFHP program. If your test is not covered, you will be required to pay for this testing at time of sample collection. LifeLabs accepts cash, cheque, Visa, Mastercard and debit card.
