CHANGES TO NT-PROBNP TESTING

Dear Health Care Providers.

Please be advised that effective 08 Jul 2024, there will be changes to the NT-proBNP test reports. The methodology and reference interval remains the same. The reference interval applies for the outpatient setting. The interpretive comments will be removed from the test report and the updated interpretive comments^{1,2} will be provided in our lab test information page: tests.lifelabs.com

This update facilitates appropriate interpretation of the test depending on the clinical utility of the test (acute care setting, outpatient setting, etc.) while keeping the test report concise.

To access the interpretive comments:

- 1) Go to: https://tests.lifelabs.com
- 2) In the Search for tests tab, type "NT pro BNP" in the Enter full or partial name or keyword search box
- 3) Select "Ontario" in the Region section and click search.
- 4) In the search results, select "NT-prob-type natriuretic peptide."
- 5) Scroll down to the "Reference Ranges" section to view the interpretive guide.
