## DO NOT USE HISTOLOGY BAGS FOR CYTOLOGY SPECIMENS

Dear Health Care Providers,

Recently, there has been a significant increase in the number of Cytology/OCSP specimens received in dedicated Histology specimen collection bags. This bulletin serves as reminder to ensure that specimens for Histology are placed in specimen collection bags that are labelled with **HISTOLOGY SPECIMEN** and that Cytology/OCSP specimens are placed in the clear plastic collection bags. Please refer to the images in the table below.
