# Changes to trichomonas vaginalis testing

### **Issued By**

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#### Overview

- Effective **December 3, 2018** LifeLabs BC is changing testing methodology for *Trichomonas vaginalis* to NAAT (nucleic acid amplification) testing.
- Trichomonas antigen testing by EIA will be <u>discontinued</u>.

<u>Important:</u> Samples submitted to LifeLabs for trichomonas testing must be either urine (male or female) or on an APTIMA swab.

**Note:** This is the same collection system used for chlamydia/gonorrhea testing. Trichomonas and chlamydia/gonorrhea testing can now be performed on a single specimen.

## **Collection Changes**

- Effective December 3, 2018, please submit urine or an APTIMA swab for trichomonas testing (same collection as for chlamydia/gonorrhea).
- Testing can now be performed on males and females.
- Testing for trichomonas cannot be performed using samples collected with the red topped Liquid Amies swab.
